
HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION POLICY*

We recommend that students live with one of our homestay providers so that they can experience real British life. All our homestay providers are friendly and welcoming.

Arrival and departure

Students normally arrive on a Sunday and leave on a Saturday. Students or their agents are responsible for informing the Centre about their travel plans and arrival times.

Monday to Friday

Students should be at school from 09.00 to 16.00 on weekdays – and not at their accommodation - unless they are unwell.

If a student is ill or cannot come to school, he/she must telephone the school no later than 09.00.

Lifestyle

Living in a different country can be strange at first but our homestay providers will help you. In return, we expect our students to be tolerant of the different lifestyle and habits in their homestay.

CESC can find homestay accommodation only for students who adapt to living in a British household and behave reasonably.

Changing your homestay

We cannot change homestay accommodation just because students think it is too far away.

Students can ask for a change of homestay accommodation but we cannot guarantee to find a different provider.

Students must give at least 7 days' notice ending on a Saturday if they want to change their homestay accommodation.

Students should leave their homestay accommodation when their course has finished. In special situations, permission may be given by the Accommodation team for students to stay in their homestay accommodation for a short period before they return home or before they begin another course of study in a different place.

Students cannot stay in CESC-contracted homestay accommodation while studying in a different place.

Homestay providers are contracted to supply homestay accommodation services to CESC. CESC is contracted to provide these services to those students who pay for them. There is no contract between a homestay provider and the student staying in their home.
